

Past Master Councilor Policy

Effective: 24 July 2022

DeMolays elected to the position of Master Councilor in their Chapter in the Jurisdiction of Georgia shall be required to complete the PMC-MSA process, including submitting the preliminary letter and proper term plans no later than 10 days after installation and submitting a final letter outlining the activities of the term no later than 10 days after the conclusion of the term or installation of the next Master Councilor, whichever is the earlier date.

No DeMolay shall be designated or recognized as a Past Master Councilor or receive the benefits thereof if he should fail to complete the PMC-MSA process. This includes but is not limited to:

- Master Councilor term reporting in eScribe
- Receiving or wearing of PMC pin or jewel
- Receiving Master Councilor Officer Service Certificate
- Inclusion in Chapter historical records denoting the individual as a Past Master Councilor
- Use of the "PMC" suffix with the individual's name
- Being qualified to serve as a jurisdictional officer.

Note that EARNING the PMC-MSA award is NOT required to be recognized as a Past Master Councilor.
